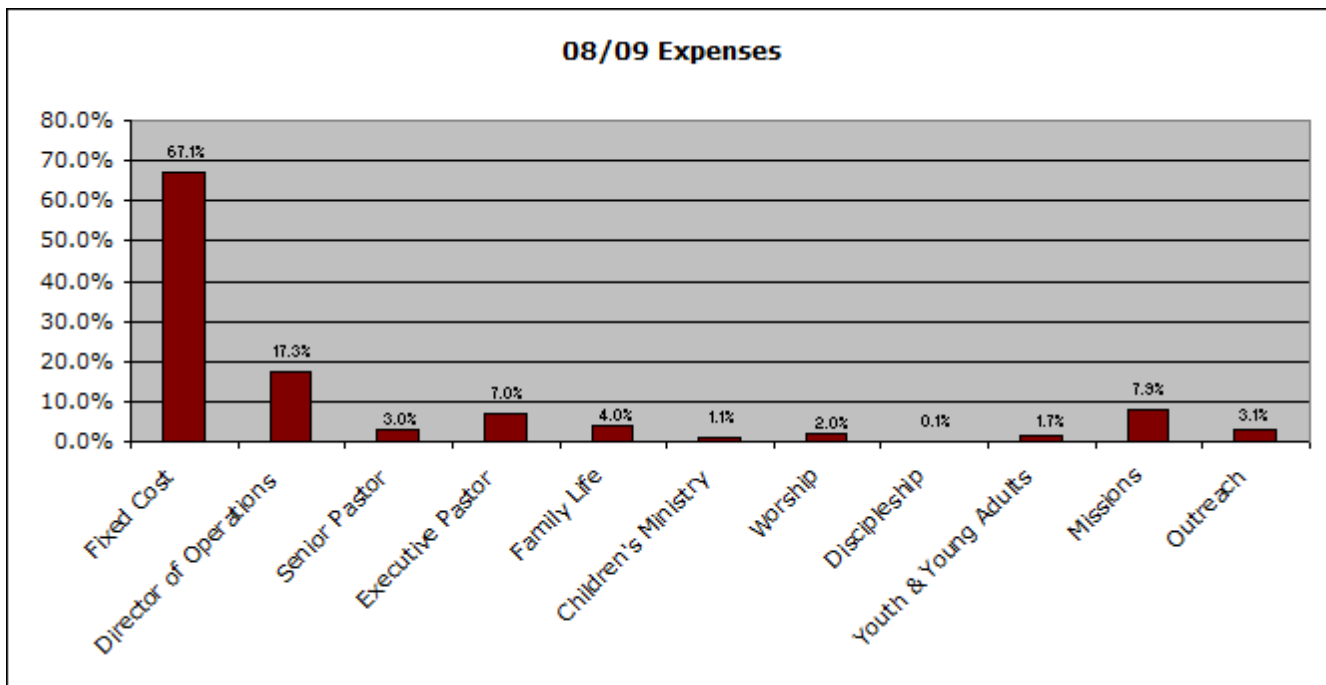
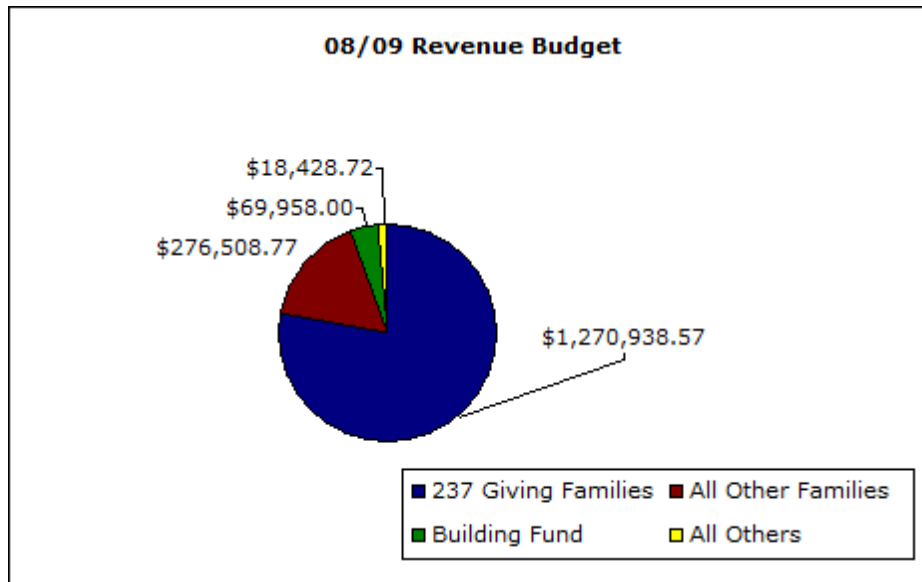


**Heartland Vineyard Church

Interesting facts about our givers and our giving...

1. Regular offerings in 2008/2009 were up 5.1%, which was about \$75,179.
2. We estimate about 30% of our donors are giving a tithe (10%).
3. In 2008/2009 we gave \$170,932.71 to Missions and Outreach. Typically we give a minimum of 10% away in this area this year we gave 11.5%.

Heartland Vineyard Church Fiscal year 2008/2009 Missions and Outreach Report

The Heartland Vineyard church continues to expand in generosity giving over \$170,000 toward missions and outreach last year. Missions and Outreach are our two main areas of giving back into our community and the world this amount is around 11% of our total yearly budget. The following is a brief report on how that money was spent.

1. Our largest amount spent for the year went toward the Association of Vineyard Churches (AVC), and this amount totaled \$46,170.59. This money is about 29% of the overall Missions & Outreach budget and goes toward our Regional and National fund that continue the efforts worldwide in spreading and cultivating new churches.
2. We paid \$16,500 toward our Mexico partnership. This money goes into a regional fund that helps offset many costs in Mexico and the efforts there. We also were able to fund leaders and support mission and relief efforts for three Mexico trips last year totaling over \$12,000.
3. We were able to support 4 full-time missionary families and 2 national mission agencies with monies totaling over \$17,980, which is around 16% of our overall Missions & Outreach budget.
4. We paid out over \$51,000 in outreach money for the year; this would include items bought from the food bank to give away, food items from Martin brothers for outreaches toward Country Terrace and other areas. As well as other events and any miscellaneous outreach items bought throughout the year.
5. We have given over \$26,000 out in assistance to needy families and individuals in and outside of our church.
6. And our church has generously donated and given out over; 650 grocery bags, 86 turkeys at Thanksgiving, over 600 lbs of ground pork and over 100 school bags and supplies for school kids.

Being generous is an integral part of living a Kingdom lifestyle as told to us in 2Cor 9: 7. And our desire is to be Kingdom people, so as we raise up leaders who are willing to follow Jesus for the sake of others. We want to do so with joyous hearts and attitudes of love.
