

Sprout Preschool Information

Registration Information

Our program will be a 3-hour program from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Sprout offers an early drop off program that starts at 7:45 a.m. Sprout operates three different classes: a 2 year old class; a 3 and 4 year old class; and a pre-kindergarten class (4 and 5 year olds).

2 year old class

- 2 days per week (Tuesday and Thursday)

3 and 4 year old class, children planning to attend kindergarten in two years, can meet either:

- 3 days per week (Monday, Wednesday, Friday)
- 5 days per week (Monday through Friday)

Pre-kindergarten class, children who will attend kindergarten the following year, will meet:

- 5 days per week (Monday through Friday)

The pre-kindergarten class will be working on kindergarten readiness, which will help them acclimate to attending school 5 days per week. This is why we offer only one program for that age group.

Our school year will start the Tuesday after Labor Day and continue through the Friday before Memorial Day.

Enrollment & Fees

Two year olds do not need to be potty trained. However, in order to qualify for enrollment in our other classes your child must be at least 3 years of age and must be completely potty trained. An annual, non-refundable enrollment fee of \$50 will be collected prior to enrolling your child each year.

Sprout Preschool is a ministry of Heartland Vineyard Church. It is a non-profit organization. Fees are charged in relation to operational costs. The current year's tuition rates are:

- 2 days per week (Tuesday, Thursday) \$100/month*
- 3 days per week (Monday, Wednesday, Friday) \$125/month*
- 5 days per week (Monday through Friday) \$175/month*

- The early drop off fee is \$2.50* each time it is used

Other Things

Along with the registration fee, there are supply and field trip fees that are due before the first day of school.

- \$25 supply fee
- \$25 field trip fee

Before school starts, there will be a welcome letter sent out with a list of materials that your child is encouraged to bring. These supplies will be shared with the class throughout the year.

Sprout Preschool also encourages each child to bring a snack and juice that can be shared with the other students once per month. There will be a monthly calendar sent out at the beginning of each month with a list of healthy snacks as well as a list of the number of children that snacks will be provided for.

A Parent Orientation Meeting will be held before school starts. This is an informational meeting that will provide answers to any questions and will cover Sprout's parent handbook and policies.

We will also hold a Kids' Open House that will allow your child to come and see their classroom before school starts. We ask that kids only attend the open house.

The dates for the Parent Orientation Meeting and the Kids' Open House will be noted in the welcome letter.

We follow the Cedar Falls School District school year calendar for holidays, in-service days, spring break, etc. If there are any snow days, we will post them on KWWL as "Sprout Preschool – Cedar Falls." If Cedar Falls Schools are delayed or closed, we will not hold school that day. If there are days that are questionable or that Sprout Preschool staff feels are not safe for travel even when Cedar Falls Schools are starting on time, we will post on KWWL and our Facebook page that there will be no school.
